PATCHWORK QUILT GROUP COMPETITION

Rules & Regulations

**This new competition is currently open to all shows and groups to adopt.*

**** If group support is sufficient the RAS will be invited to conduct a State Final starting 2021*

1. The exhibit is to be not more than one metre on any one side (rectangle or square shape only)
2. Framed and board mounted exhibits not permitted.
3. Must be machine pieced and machine quilted.
4. Minimal Embellishments. Small amount only not to overpower patchwork.
5. Each exhibit entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
6. An exhibit having won at a Show will compete at a Group Final.
7. An exhibit is only eligible to represent one Society at Group level and one Group at State level
8. If, for any reason, a winner is unable to compete at Group level then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.
9. All work to have been completed in the last eighteen (18) months prior to its entry at a local show.
10. An exhibit that has previously competed at Group level is not eligible to compete again.
11. If this class is not scheduled or attracts no entries at a local show, the Chief Pavilion Steward in consultation with the appropriate Pavilion Section Judges, may select a suitable quilt and, with the exhibitor's permission, enter them in the Group judging as an exhibit representing the particular Society concerned.
12. Group Final location and date is to be determined by the Group. It is the responsibility of either the exhibitor or the Show Society to ensure the quilt is delivered on Judging Day and collected in an appropriate time frame after the competition.



PURE WOOL ARTICLE-GARMENT

STATE COMPETITION

COMPETITION TO BE CONDUCTED AT SOCIETY – GROUP AND STATE LEVEL.

CLASS: THREE WOOL ARTICLES – GARMENTS DISTINCT.

Articles – garments may be knitted – crocheted or constructed in wool fabric or raw wool
(Minimum wool content 80%).

CONDITIONS

1. All three Articles-Garments must have been made within twelve months of the local show and made by exhibitor.
2. An exhibitor having won at a local show may exhibit the same three articles at the Group Final. The winner at the Group Final may then exhibit the same three exhibits at the RAS State Final.
3. An exhibitor having won at local show level is not eligible to enter this class at any other show until after Group judging, when, if not having the winning entry, may then compete further.
4. An exhibitor is only eligible to represent one Society at Group level and one Group at State Level.
5. An exhibitor having won at Group level CANNOT compete further until after the Royal Show.
6. Sample of commercial wool and label to be attached.
