WRITTEN ENTRIES CLOSE AT 5PM FRIDAY 30TH AUGUST 2019

- ◆ Exhibits to be penned no later than 9 am. on the morning of the Show. Handling birds, or attempting to remove birds from coops, whether during the Show or on the expiration thereof will render the person on so doing liable to disqualification, and prize money will be forfeited.
- ◆ **This rule will be strictly enforced.** Stewards will attend to penning and to exhibitors requests.
- ◆ All exhibits to be proved bona-fide property of the person exhibiting, and to have been so for 28 days prior to the Show.
- ◆ Exhibitors must remain outside of roped off area of Poultry Pavilion whilst judging is in progress.
- ◆ Entry numbers will be available at the poultry pavilion.
- ◆ Juniors are eligible for Champion Exhibits.
- ◆ Every care taken for birds but no responsibility incurred.
- ◆ Any bird considered by stewards to be infested with vermin or suffering from a disease will be removed from the pavilion – entry fee will be forfeited,
- ◆ All birds must be unpenned by 5pm Saturday unless prior arrangements are made with Chief Steward.
- ◆ A Junior Exhibitor must be 16years or under as of the day of the show
- ◆ A person shall not be eligible to compete in a junior section if he/she lives at the same address as an Open Exhibitor, unless the Open Exhibitor exhibits in a different class than that exhibited by the Junior Exhibitor
- ◆ An exhibitor may enter in either open or Junior NOT both
- ◆ Any person causing annoyance by commenting on the judge's decision, or insulting/unseemly behavior, shall be liable to exclusion from the show, and exhibit and/or rewards disqualified
- ◆ Leg rings must be removed
- ◆ NO person is permitted to handle or interfere with the exhibits or handle another exhibitor's birds with exemption of the Chief Steward, Stewards or Judges. Exhibitors are not to handle their birds once judging has commenced.
- ◆ Birds entered are eligible for CHAMPION awards.
- ◆ Juniors must pen their own birds.
